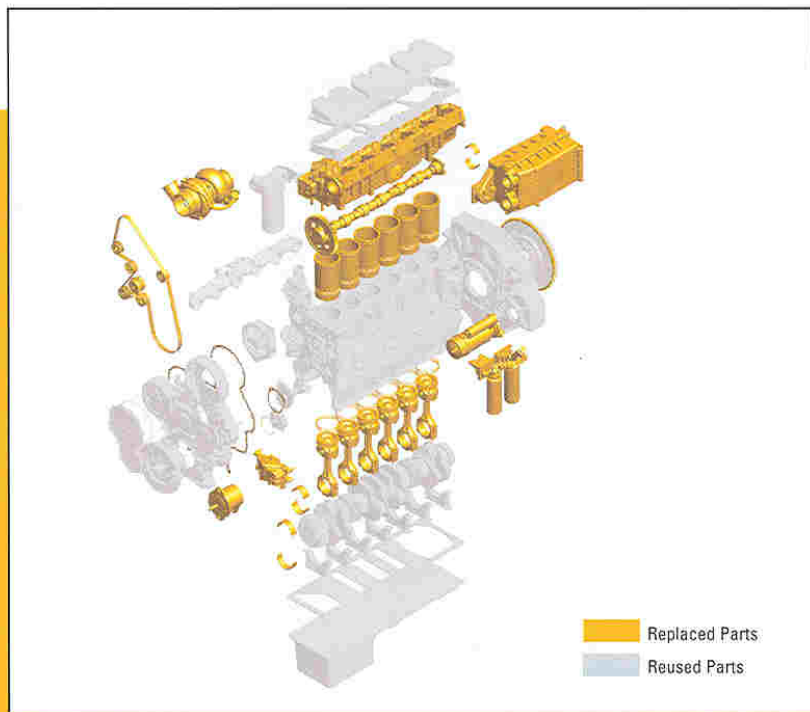

## HOW DO I KNOW WHEN A REBUILD WILL BE DUE?

Your Cat dealer will work with you to review your fleet and application to help you assess the right time for a rebuild – it may be sooner or later, depending on the circumstances. This process will include a 'problem indicator' assessment covering issues causing concern on a daily basis.

### Problem Indicators include:

- Abnormal oil and fuel consumption
- Noise or vibration
- Excessive smoke
- Leaks
- Overheating
- Loss of power or difficulty starting
- Metal in oil or filters

Valuable information can be gained through 'planned indicators' – a series of scheduled tests that can be undertaken by your own mechanics. We can package these ongoing checks as part of a flexible Customer Support Agreement or a series of inspections.

- Machine hours and history
- S-O-S<sup>™</sup> trends
- Inspections
- Fuel consumption
- Experience
- Site Operation and Maintenance Advisor

## What criteria must I meet to be eligible for a Cat Engine Fixed Price Rebuild?

- The engine must be fully assembled, complete with genuine Cat<sup>®</sup> parts
- The engine must start, run and be operational
- The cylinder block must not be visibly cracked, broken or welded
- There must be no excessive rust, corrosion, pitting or fire damage
